

## How to get to BMA House

As well as functioning as a leading London conference location, BMA House (originally known as Tavistock House) is the headquarters of the British Medical Association. The venue benefits from excellent transport connections.

- By tube, Euston (Northern and Victoria lines), Russell Square (Piccadilly line), Euston Square (Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith & City lines) are only a few minutes walk away.
- By train, Euston, King's Cross/St Pancras and Marylebone stations are close by.
- By car, there is easy access from the M1 and M40 motorways. Limited car parking is available at BMA House with advance warning. An NCP car park is a few minutes walk away.
- Heathrow and city airports are both less than an hour away.

## Local attractions



BMA House is within walking distance of the British Museum and British Library and a short journey from the shops and theatres of the West End. There is an excellent selection of hotels covering a range of prices all within the vicinity of BMA House.
